Addressing the Growing Needs of Food Allergic Patients

- 1 in 13 children have a food allergy (Gupta et al., Pediatrics 2018)
- Numerous studies detail negative effect of food allergy on health-related quality of life (HR-QOL) (Muraro et al., Allergy 2014)
- High rates of anxiety and depression in food allergic children (Flokstra-de Blok et al., Allergy 2010)
